Police Charge Man with Aggravated Statutory Rape

Andrae Stewart, 34, of Medon, turned himself in this morning at the Jackson Police Department after police issued a warrant for his arrest. He was arraigned Tuesday in Jackson City Court on three counts of aggravated statutory rape. He is free on \$2,500 bond and court ordered to have no contact with the victim, a 14-year-old boy. His next scheduled court appearance is on March 15 in City Court.

These charges stem from a joint investigation by police and the Tennessee Department of Children's Services. The investigation thus far has shown that Stewart engaged in sexual contact with the boy between 2010 and 2011. The investigation is ongoing.
