

MINUTES
BEER BOARD MEETING
February 3, 2009

The Jackson, Tennessee Beer Board met at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 3, 2009, in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Present were Board members Charles “Pepper” Bray and Johnny Dodd. Board member Charles Rahm was not present. Also present were Lewis Cobb, City Attorney; Gary Hardee, Neighborhood Services Coordinator for Codes Enforcement; and Anita Brooks, recorder of the minutes.

The meeting was called to order. On the motion of Board member Bray, seconded by Chairman Dodd, the minutes of the January 6, 2009 meeting were approved and signed.

Chairman Dodd presented an application for an establishment known as Apple Nine Hospitality Management, Inc., doing business as Courtyard Jackson, located at 200 Campbell Oaks Drive, for “selling and serving beer in a hotel.” Mr. Robert Northup and Ms. Kathleen Yarborough, representatives for the business, were present and advised that the permit was requested because a real estate action exchange had occurred. On the motion of Chairman Dodd, seconded by board member Bray, the application was unanimously approved.

Chairman Dodd presented an application for an establishment known as Morris One Stop, located at 1430 East Chester Street, for “selling, storing and distributing for consumption off the premises.” Ms. Lisa Jones, owner, was present. On the motion of Chairman Dodd, seconded by Board member Bray, the application was unanimously approved.

The Board recessed at 8:18 a.m. and reconvened at 8:25 a.m.

Chairman Dodd presented an application for an establishment known as Mor For Less, Inc., located at 419 East College Street, for “selling, storing and distributing for consumption off the premises.” Mr. Akram L. Nagi, owner, was present. On the motion of Chairman Dodd, seconded by Board member Bray, the application was unanimously approved.
