

MINUTES
BEER BOARD MEETING
April 2, 2009

The Jackson, Tennessee Beer Board met at 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 2, 2009, in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Present were Board members Charles “Pepper” Bray, Johnny Dodd and Charles Rahm. Also present were Lewis Cobb, City Attorney; and Anita Brooks, recorder of the minutes.

The meeting was called to order. On the motion of Board member Rahm, seconded by Board member Bray, the minutes of the March 10, 2009 meeting were approved and signed.

Chairman Dodd presented a request from the University School of Jackson for a special occasion permit to sell, store and serve beer at the Carl Perkins Civic Center on April 25, 2009 for a school fundraiser. Ms. Angela Spencer and Ms. Gina Smith were present. On the motion of Board member Bray, seconded by Board member Rahm, the request was unanimously approved.

Chairman Dodd advised the City Attorney and Board members about the time span Captain Gerry Campbell of the Jackson Police Department had requested to process background checks for beer applicants. Chairman Dodd also asked the City Attorney about the status of holding a Show Cause Hearing for the beer permit holders who were recently charged with selling beer to a minor. The City Attorney advised the Beer Board to let the permit holders go through the criminal process to work out their pleas before considering what action the Board would take against the beer permit holders.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
